RANK REQUIREMENTS

do **ALL** of these:

1—Be active in your Webelos den for at least six months since completing the fourth grade (or for at least six months since becoming 10 years old), and earn the Webelos badge .									
2—Show your knowledge of the <i>Boy Scout</i> requirements: do ALL of these									
2a—Repeat from memory & explain the Scout Oath or Promise and the 12 points of the Scout Law . Tell how you practice them in your everyday life.									
2b—Give and explain the Scout motto , slogan , sign, salute, and handshake.									
2c—Describe the parts and significance of the First Class Scout badge.									
2d—Tell how a Boy Scout uniform is different from a Webelos uniform.									
2e—Tie the joining knot (square knot)									
3— Earn at least eight Activity Badges . These must include:									
Fitness and Citizen [already earned for Webelos rank]									
Readyman and Outdoorsman									
At least one from the Mental Skills Group									
At least one from the Technology Group									
Two more Activity Badges of your choice.									
4—With your den, visit at least 1 troop meeting, AND 1 Boy Scout-oriented outdoor activity. (<i>BESIDES the ones used for your Outdoorsman activity badge</i>)									
5—Participate in a Webelos overnight campout or day hike. (<i>BESIDES the one used for your Outdoorsman activity badge</i>)									
6—After completing the above [5] requirements, visit a Boy Scout troop meeting and have a conference with the Scoutmaster.									
7—Complete the Honesty Character Connection . Know: Say the Cub Scout Promise to your family. Discuss these questions with them. What is a promise? What does it mean to keep your word? What does it mean to be trustworthy? What does <i>honesty</i> mean? Commit: Discuss these questions with your family. Why is a promise important? Why is it important for people to trust you when you give your word? When might it be difficult to be truthful? List examples. Practice: Discuss with a family member why it is important to be trustworthy and honest. How can you do your best to be honest even when it is difficult?
