Do this:

1—With an adult, complete the Respect Character Connection.									
1a—KNOW: Tell what interested you most in completing these requirements, and what you learned about showing respect and appreciation for wildlife.									
1b—COMMIT: Tell some things that others have done that show a lack of respect for wildlife. Name ways you will show respect for and protect wildlife.									
1c—PRACTICE: Explain how completing these badge requirements gives you the opportunity to show respect.									
<b>And, do FIVE of these:</b>									
2—Keep an insect zoo; study them, then release them; tell den about it.									
3—Set up and keep an aquarium or terrarium for at least a month; tell den.									
4—Visit a museum of natural history, nature center or zoo with your family, den or pack. Tell what you saw.									
5—Watch & identify birds in your yard/neighborhood/town for a week. Keep a log.									
6—Learn about nearby bird flyways, and which birds use them.									
7—Learn to identify poisonous plants and venomous reptiles in your area.									
8—Watch six wild animals in the wild. Describe the place and animal activity									
9—Give examples of [1] producer, consumer, & decomposer in a food chain in an ecosystem; [2] one way humans have changed balance of nature; [3] how you help protect the balance of nature.									
10—Identify a plant/bird/animal found only in your area, and tell why.									
11—Learn about aquatic ecosystems & wetlands in your area. Discuss the important role they play in the lifecycles of wildlife and humans.									
12—Identify & clean up neighborhood litter that is dangerous to birds/animals. What else can you do to make it safe for animals?									
13—While a Webelos, earn Academic belt loop for Wildlife Conservation.
