DO THIS:

1—With an adult, complete the Responsibility Character Connection.									
1a—KNOW: List tasks you can think of that are necessary to keep a household in good shape. Name tasks that are your responsibility. Tell what it means to be responsible for these tasks.									
1b—COMMIT: Talk about what happens when people don't do their jobs. Tell why it's important to be helpful and responsible. List ways you can be more responsible on your own.									
1c—PRACTICE: Choose one of the requirements and show how you are responsible by doing that task well for two weeks.									
<u>And, do SIX of these:</u>									
2—Wash a car [with an adult]									
3—Change a tire on a car [with an adult]									
4—Replace a lightbulb on a car [with an adult].									
5—Check the oil level and tire pressure on a car [with an adult].									
6—Make a repair to a bike [adjust chain, seat, bars; or fix a flat]									
7—Lubricate the chain on a bike.									
8—Properly inflate the tires on a bike.									
9—Change wheels on skateboard or in-line skates.									
10—Replace a light bulb in a fixture or lamp.									
11—Arrange a safe storage area for household cleaners & dangerous materials.									
12—Build a sawhorse or stool to use around the home									
13—Help take care of the lawn									
14—Arrange a storage area for hand tools, or lawn/garden tools.									
15—Clean and store properly hand or lawn/garden tools.									
16—Label hand tools or lawn/garden tools.									
17—Put together a toolbox for common household repairs.
