Who: 1st Class Scouts who are at least 14 but not yet 18 years of age. Limit of two Scouts per unit; max of 96 Scouts per session. Unit Leader approval is required for this event and will be verified.

What: SOGUS is a seven-day outdoor leadership training experience for Troop, Varsity, and Venturing boy leaders. SOGUS teaches basic leadership skills in a challenging outdoor environment and uses high adventure activities as a back drop for instruction.

The course has four aims: The first aim is for a Scout relate to his Patrol, Troop, or Team the job skills of leadership that have proven effective in a variety of Scouting and personal leadership situations. The second aim is to give each participant a varied experience in Scoutcraft skills that can be shared with the members of his Patrol, Troop, or Team. The third aim is to give participants a chance to relate to leaders from other Troops, or Teams for an exchange of ideas and experiences. The fourth aim is to have FUN!

When/Where: June 18-24, Camp Cooper near Willamina.

How much? \$230 fee due in full by May 16, 2008 (deposit of \$60 due at time of reservation). A completed Opportunity Fund Application may be submitted for Cascade Pacific Council Scouts who need financial help to attend camp. Only one opportunity fund application per person/per year will be approved.

How to register? Go to www.cpcbasa.org/register starting February 1, 2008.

Have the following information:

Participant Information: Youth Name, Address, City, State, Zip, Phone Number, Date of Birth, Youth Email, Special Needs, Parent Name, and Parent Email.

Insurance Information: Unit or Personal Insurance Company, and Policy Number.

Unit Information: Unit Type, Unit Number, District, and Council (if different than Cascade Pacific Council).

Unit Leader's Information: Leader Name, Phone Number, and Email. *Unit Leader approval is required for this event and will be verified.*

Payment:

A non-refundable deposit (\$60) is due at time of reservation. **The commitment fee (\$170) is due by May 16, 2008.** You have the option to make an online or offline payment. Offline payments should be sent to the Cascade Pacific Council, BSA, 2145 SW Naito Pkwy, Portland, OR, 97201 with a copy of your reservation confirmation. **You can access your reservation to pay the commitment fee (\$170). Go to the SOGUS reservation page and click on To edit an existing reservation.**

Refund Policy

By May 16, 2008: Refund of commitment fee (\$170) only; OR all fees may be transferred to a replacement reservation from the same troop. Requests to transfer fees to a replacement reservation must be in writing.

Between May 16th and two weeks prior to camp: No refund, but all fees paid may be transferred to a replacement reservation from the same troop.

Within two weeks of camp: No refund unless (1) the Scout is ill, or (2) the Scout's family has moved out of Council, or (3) there was a death or serious illness in the Scout's family. The refund is the commitment fee (\$170) only.

All Refund requests must be in writing and delivered in person, by mail, fax or e-mail to the Cascade Pacific Council by July 31, 2008. Refunds will be sent to the registered Troop Committee Chair in the first week of October.
