A minimum of 10 riders are required for half day rides. The Butte Creek Wranglers are in charge at all times, and their decisions must be heeded. Horseback riding is available to second year Webelos (5th grade) and older.

PAYMENT AND REFUND POLICY

A deposit of \$6.00 per horse is due upon application. Deposits are refundable with more than 60 days written notice of cancellation. All fees are due 30 days prior to ride or groups may risk forfeiture of rides and deposit. Refunds are allowed only with 30 days or more advance notice of cancellations for one or all horses. All fees must be paid at the Council Office. RESERVATIONS ARE ON A FIRST COME-FIRST SERVED BASIS.

RULES OF THE ROAD

1. All units must CHECK-IN with the Wrangler or Campmaster upon arrival.
2. All units must CHECK-OUT with the Wrangler or Campmaster before leaving.
3. All vehicles must remain in designated parking area.
4. No swimming in Butte Creek; fishing only at low water.
5. All open flame fires must be at least 10 feet from any building or shelter.
6. All liquid fuel cans must be left and locked in vehicles. Units must follow national policy on liquid fuel use.
7. No standing timber may be cut without permission. Cut no Conifers/brush.
8. All garbage is to be taken out of camp. Make sure all fires are out.
9. No weapons, alcoholic beverages, drugs or pets allowed on B.S.A. property.
10. Units responsible for damage will be billed for repair or replacement.
11. All units are required to have insurance to participate in the horseback riding program. If needed, short-term insurance may be purchased from the Council.
12. At least two (2) adults must accompany all units, both camping and riding.
13. Cabin/tent site must be cleaned and wood stacked before leaving camp.
14. Be a courteous camper – pay the rent by doing a service project.
