* SUMMARY *

- Plan well in advance.
- Involve the Eagle Scout and his parents.
- Request letters from prominent people (President of the United States, Senator, State Representative, Governor, Mayor, other).
- Make sure the Eagle Court of Honor is a Special Event.
- Send invitations to friends and all parents in the Troop.
- Invite community, church, and school leaders.
- Print programs.
- Obtain local newspaper coverage.
- Consider presenting a special Eagle neckerchief, ring, or belt buckle, or a special plaque.

CONDUCT A GOOD COURT OF HONOR:

- √Use a printed agenda.
- √Ensure that speakers know what to say.
- √Ensure that presenters know when to make presentation.
- √Practice (walk through).
- √Include all elements - leave nothing out.
- √Be professional.
- √Have a reception with refreshments - an Eagle cake is appropriate.
