## Covid-19 Facts

- The COVID – 19 virus is still prevalent in our community.
- The COVID – 19 virus kills people every day, especially immunocompromised and elderly.
- The COVID – 19 virus is mainly spread by expectorating virally loaded droplets into the air.
- Many infected are asymptomatic and pose a risk to the spread of the virus.



## Covid-19 Facts

- Immunity of those who have been infected is still not well known. The virus is mutating as it grows.
  - The CDC advises that you can contract the virus again.
  - The new strain could be less or more potent.
- The CDC and the Oregon Health Authority have shared that until a vaccine is developed, social distancing will be required to stay the uncontrolled spread of this virus.

# Social Distancing

**There is no substitution for 6 feet distancing for non-family members.**

- **Pre-planning of the activity to ensure social distancing**
  - **How is the space to be used to ensure social distancing?**
  - **How are people getting to the activity?**
  - **Will face masks be practical?**
  - **Are group sizes conducive to social distancing?**
- **Discipline:**
  - **Create a Social Distancing Culture.**
  - **Treat Social Distancing infractions directly and seriously.**

# Screening

**Pre-Screening: Before attending an activity Scouts/Families must determine their health before participation.**

- **Are they Immunocompromized?**
- **Are they feeling well?**
- **Have they been exposed?**
- **Are they prepared to follow the activity safety guidelines?**

**Activity Screening: To be done at beginning of each activity.**

- **Review the pre-screening at the activity as well.**

# Sanitization

**Wash Hands with Soap and Water for 20 seconds.**

**Have 60% Alcohol Sanitizer available (11<sup>th</sup> essential):**

- This is flammable so keep away from heat or open flames.

**Bleach Solution to be 1000 ppm for surfaces that can handle it. If not use cleanable table clothes or coverings that can be bleached**

- 1/3 cup bleach per gallon. (Lasts 24 hours).

**Sanitize between uses, including hand sanitizing.**

# Oregon Phases at a glance.

## Baseline:

- **Shelter in Place.**
- **Families allowed interaction no other actions without social distancing.**

## Phase 1:

- **Groups of 25 No Traveling**
- **Families can camp together at state parks etc.**
- **Overnight group camping not allowed.**
- **Social Distancing still in place.**

# Oregon Phases at a glance.

## Phase 2:

- **Groups of 50 allowed indoors, traveling allowed.**
- **Groups of 100 allowed outdoors**
- **Outdoor group camping not allowed.**
- **Pools, bowling alleys, and other venues open.**
- **Recreational non contact sports allowed with specific guidelines**
- **Social distancing of 6ft must still be maintained.**

## Phase 3: Back to relatively normal

- **Happens after vaccine is developed and in widespread use.**

# Washington Phases at a glance.

## Phase 1:

- **Shelter in Place.**
- **Families allowed interaction no other actions without social distancing.**

## Phase 2:

- **Gather with no more than 5 people outside your household per week.**
- **Families can camp and include 5 non household members.**
- **Overnight group camping not allowed.**
- **Social Distancing still in place.**

# Washington Phases at a glance.

## Phase 3:

- **Groups of 50 allowed indoors/outdoors**
- **Non Essential traveling allowed.**
- **Outdoor group camping may be allowed. See County Rules**
- **Pools, bowling alleys, and other venues open.**
- **Social distancing of 6ft must still be maintained.**

## Phase 4:

- **Groups of over 50 allowed**
- **Outdoor recreation allowed. (Camping, etc)**





# Screening

- Those at significant risk for infection should consult a physician prior to participation in any group activities.
- All participants should review their current health prior to participation of any activity. Only those feeling well should participate. Whenever possible, temperature checks of Scouts and leaders should be made prior to participation.
- All units should produce a detailed roster of participants for all meetings and activities so they are prepared in the event that contact tracing is required.
- All those who have been exposed to Coronavirus must quarantine for 14 days prior to participation in any Scouting activity.



# Social Distancing

- Groups must always maintain social distancing of six or more feet, Including hiking, biking and other activities.
- Groups should be limited to den/patrol groups of 10 or less scouts with a minimum of 2 registered adult leaders. It is recommended that groups of Cub Scouts and parents should be in groups of 5 youth and up to 5 adults.
- Transportation to and from activities should be made within family units. No carpooling is allowed.
- When practical each Scout and adult should wear a cloth mask.
- No group camping is allowed in Oregon and only when specific Counties open up in Washington. (Travel restrictions still apply)

# Sanitization and Other.

- Handwashing and sanitation of shared supplies must be done between use.
- Families/siblings do not need to maintain social distancing for transportation, sleeping or meeting.
- If your county's status is shelter-in-place, you may not move to an open county to conduct unit activities.
- You must pay attention to your municipalities rules along with the municipality you wish to travel to. (When travel is approved)



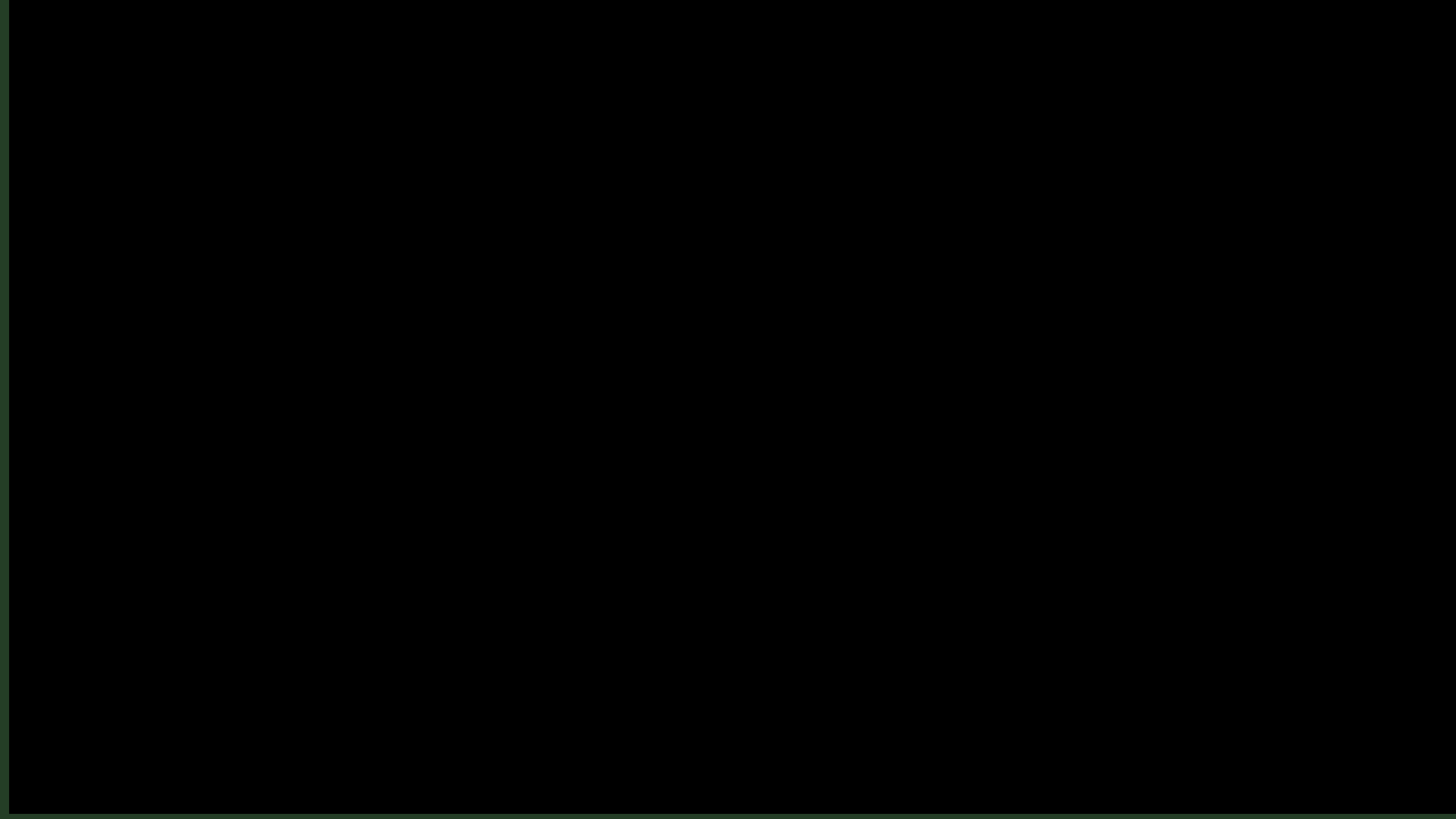

# Summer Adventure Club: Scout BSA

- Two Merit Badges offered per week.

- All programs taught by your summer camp merit badge counselors.
- Merit Badges released this week but most will be uncommon, Some Eagle Required.
- Scouts will be required to do the work and turn in evidence of completion.
- Three Hour long Zoom Sessions during the week each Merit Badge and TTFC Class
- Classes will be scheduled throughout the day. Sunday, Tues, Thurs OR Mon, Wed, Fri.
- Scoutmasters will need to sign off TTFC requirements. Scout will submit documentation to both counselor and Scoutmaster.

- Overnight at Meriwether, Clark, Baldwin and Pioneer
- Families only; like camping at state park
- Families must maintain social distancing with other families
- Camp Staff available for check in/out, sanitation and problem solving.
