

Airline Tickets and Travel Insurance

Cascade Pacific Council utilizes Educational Travel Services (ETSI) to assist with the travel plans for the pre & post BSA National Jamboree tour.

Your next steps will be to:

- A) Register your scout with ETSI for airline ticket reservations
- B) Purchase or decline optional travel insurance with Trip Mates

Directions for Registering with ETSI for Airline Tickets and Purchasing Travel Insurance

- 1 – Go to <https://etsi.groupcollect.com/go/4pj92-etsi>
- 2 - Click the green **Register** button and use your email to create an account.
- 3 – Enter your scout traveler’s personal information for ticketing.
- 4 – Choose the Scout Traveler or Adult Leader Insurable Travel Cost package as appropriate.
- 5 – Select the box for Required Consumable Supplies and Equipment for Jamboree
- 6 – Select or decline the travel insurance that best fits your family’s needs.

NOTE: \$3825 of the \$3975 total cost you will pay Cascade Pacific Council is insurable as travel related expenses. The remaining \$150 covers the cost of consumable supplies and equipment and is not insurable as a travel expense.

If you choose to purchase the travel insurance with Trip Mates you have two options:

- Standard Protection for \$174
- Enhanced (Cancel for Any Reason – CFAR) Protection for \$269

You can view the Summary of Plan Benefits by clicking on the link to Read Full Details listed under each protection option. If you wish to protect your trip with insurance through an alternate insurance company or, if you do not wish to insure your trip, you can select the button to Decline Travel Protection.

- 7 – Complete the questions on the Trip Questionnaire for the registered scout or adult traveler.
- 8 - Complete the Medial Information
- 9 – Verify the Terms and Conditions policy
- 10 – If purchasing insurance, add your billing information and complete payment for the insurance policy.

Note: No payment, other than for insurance, will be made on this site. ALL trip payments will be made directly to Cascade Pacific Council.
