

# Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills Training

**Who should attend:** Scoutmasters, Asst. Scoutmasters



## Elements of the training include:

Rank requirement skills from Tenderfoot thru 1<sup>st</sup> Class including:  
Campsite & Firesite Selection, Outdoor Ethics  
Plant ID, Animal ID, Packing & Hiking,  
Map & Compass, Ropes & Knots, Woods Tools, Cooking

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS) will be held in conjunction with the Cascade Pacific Council Scouts BSA Super Weekend. If you are attending with a Super Weekend unit, you should sleep and eat with that unit.

If you are attending without a host troop, a campsite will be provided for you.  
***Saturday lunch, which you will prepare, will be provided as part of the IOLS course.***

All other meals will either be eaten with your host unit or, if you are not attending with a unit, with the Super Weekend and IOLS staffs in the Camp Meriwether dining hall.

All participants are expected to camp in a tent overnight Saturday evening as part of the course. Classes will start Saturday morning at 9:00AM and end Sunday at Noon.
