Plant ID, Animal ID, Packing & Hiking,

Map & Compass, Ropes & Knots, Woods Tools, Cooking

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS) will be held as part of a full weekend of Outdoor Leader Training, including Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO) which is required training for Cub Scout camping. If you are interested in also attending BALOO, which starts Friday evening, please select the combined course option when registering.

Saturday Lunch, Dinner & Cracker Barrel and Sunday Breakfast will be provided as part of the IOLS course.

All participants are expected to camp in a tent overnight Saturday evening as part of the course. Classes will start Saturday morning at 9:00AM and end Sunday at Noon.
