Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS) will be held in conjunction with the Cascadia District ScoutsBSA Camporee. If you are attending with a Camporee unit, you should sleep and eat with that unit.

If you are attending without a host troop, a campsite will be provided for you.

Saturday lunch, which you will prepare, will be provided for all IOLS

participants as part of the IOLS course.

All other meals will either be eaten with your host unit or, if you are not attending with a unit, you will eat with the IOLS and Camporee staff.

All participants are expected to camp in a tent overnight Saturday evening as part of the course. Classes will start Saturday morning at 9:00AM and end Sunday at Noon.
